PRACTICAL INFORMATION AND PROGRAMME

Accommodation and meals

Participants will be required to make the room reservations and pay for both accommodation and meals directly to the hotel. For the period of 15/09-18/09, special prices, 100€ single room/night and 144,50€ double room/night are offered for the IPC participants at the Hotel Santa Claus, Rovaniemi. Airport transfer

Hotel Santa Claus is located at the centre of Rovaniemi. A regular bus connection from Rovaniemi airport to the city centre is operated by Airportbus, and to Pyhä-Luosto resort by SkiBus. The bus timetables align with arrivals and departures, https://www.finavia.fi/en/rovaniemi/arriving/. There is a bus stop close to the conference hotel. The bus fare is about 7€ one way, and can be paid either by cash or card. Taxis are on call at the taxi stand in front of the airport during the scheduled arrival times.

Interpreting

The conference language will be in English. There will be no interpreting during the conference.

Visa to Finland

All Russian and CIS citizens, when entering Finland and other countries under the Schengen agreement, have to apply for a visa. Schengen visas have to be obtained from the embassy / consulate of the country where the main purpose of travel lies.
