## **AIM OF THE EVENT**

The aim of the event is to give the youth from Barents Euro-Arctic area a chance to have a say on the future of Europe. The event will facilitate and enable cross-border dialogues for youth origin from Finland, Sweden, Norway and Russia. The dialogues will have pre-selected themes, but the participants can also introduce topics on the table during the discussions. The dialogues are organized in a "timeout format" and a professional will moderate each dialogue. The event should focus on citizens' ideas and the active involvement of participants. Ms Tytti Tuppurainen, Minister for European Affairs and Ownership Steering of Finland, will participate the event.

## The participants for the event

Schools, youth organizations, regional councils and municipalities will be asked for a help in inviting as well as The Barents Regional Youth Council (BRYC). BRYC consists of youth representatives from Norway, Russia, Sweden and Finland.
