- 5.3.1 The Norwegian Barents Secretariat has started the work on establishment of a business program for indigenous peoples in the BEAR. The issue was discussed in a meeting with the state secretaries of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Labour and Inclusion in June 2009.
  - Lars Miguel Utsi from the International Barents Secretariat informs about the progress in the IE project.
  - There is no news from Árran regarding the work on the Code of Conduct.
- 5.3.2 Kola Saami Radio has still not started their FM broadcasting, and the new deadline is December 2009. This complicates the establishment of an indigenous media network.
  - Saami University College is working on establishment of a Kildin Saami language centre in Lovozero.
  - No actions taken on the matter of scholarship arrangements for indigenous students.
- 5.3.3 No news regarding development or strengthening of mobile health service in the Kola Peninsula and Nenets Autonomous Okrug.

- Saami Womens' Forum arranges various seminars etc. aiming at women.
- 5.3.4 The Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs is interested in projects aiming at improving the quality of drinking water in the Barents Euro-Arctic Region.
  - No news regarding protection and documentation of indigenous peoples' traditional use of areas.
  - There is not any knownongoing project regarding restoration of industrial or military areas within the Russian Federation. In Norway, there is a project going on in Troms (Mauken).
- 5.3.5 No efforts made so far regarding establishment of scholarships for indigenous artists.
  - No efforts made regarding establishment of scholarships for indigenous sports activities.
  - Various festivals are taking place.
- 5.3.6 The Saami Parliamentary Council maintains its support to the Council of Authorized Representatives of the Saami in Murmansk Oblast (SUPS MO).
  - The Norwegian Barents Secretariat and Gáldu are preparing the Barents Indigenous Peoples' Congress and the following conference.
  - The Saami Council arranged a seminar in October on Saami rights in the Russian side.

Currently, there is no funding for participation in the Working Groups to which the WGIP has appointed representatives.

Applications are sent by the WGIP secretariat, but each WGIP member is responsible for being in contact with the respective ministries, preferential through the respective Saami Parliament or similar body.
