PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Bring warm clothes!

Temperatures in Kirkenes can vary between -5 to -25 centigrades in February.

We recommend that you bring warm clothes and comfortable shoes, and are prepared to walk short distances (max. 10 minutes) within the town center of Kirkenes.

Some of the events of Barents Spektakel may also take place outside.
