Parliamentary election is approaching

- One year to next Parliamentary election
- Unclear Parliamentary election to be expected
- Health topics will be important election issues



Committee on Primary Health Care

- First report in May 2017
- Swedish weakness long waiting times
- Proposal for three-day time limit for medical assessment – by appropriate profession
- Three-day proposal harshly criticized
- Norwegian PHC system positively discussed in media



Gender equality – next steps

 Parliamentary approval for Government agency for gender equality – by 2018



Several Parliamentary Committees in 2018

- On long-term sick leave management:
 - supportive measures for persons on sick leave
 - reforms of regulations to support return to work
 - adaptation to flexible labour markets, including project assignment and flexible hours
- On increases of individuals' life-long work years
 - increased lower limits for public pension benefits
 - regulatory measures for supplementary and private pensions
 - ideas to lower labour market entry age for youth (?)



Regional restructuring

- No political momentum on the cancelled proposal for merger of Swedish regions – from 21 to six
- Regional restructuring not on the political agenda
