Application process - status

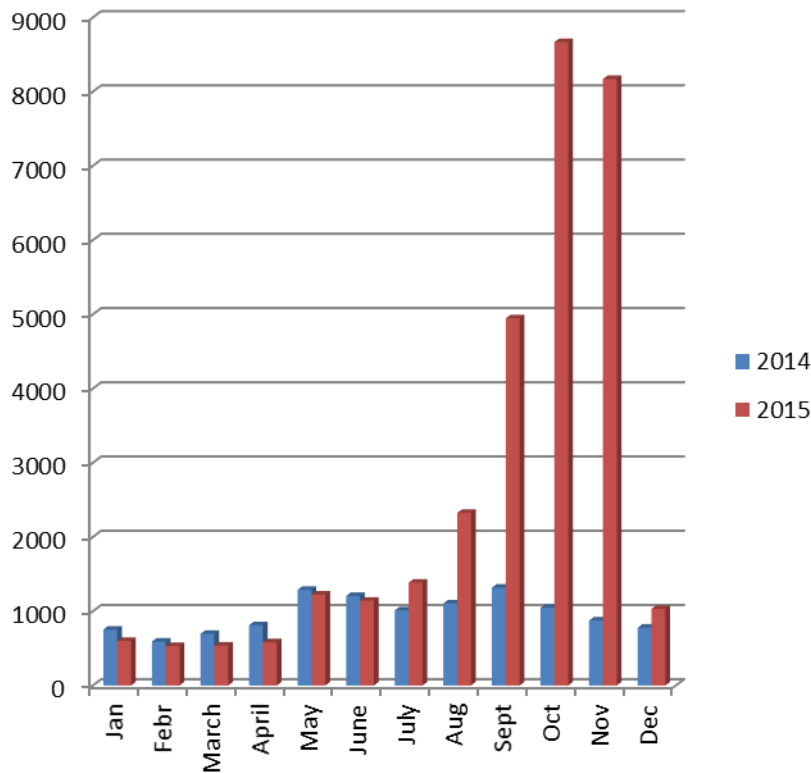
- Received 35 applications with a sum of 22, 3 mill NOK (2,5 mill euro)
- Projects with a total sum of 6 mill NOK (700 000 euro) were supported
- The funds for 2017 will be announced next year and the deadline will be February 2017

Application process – status (cont.)

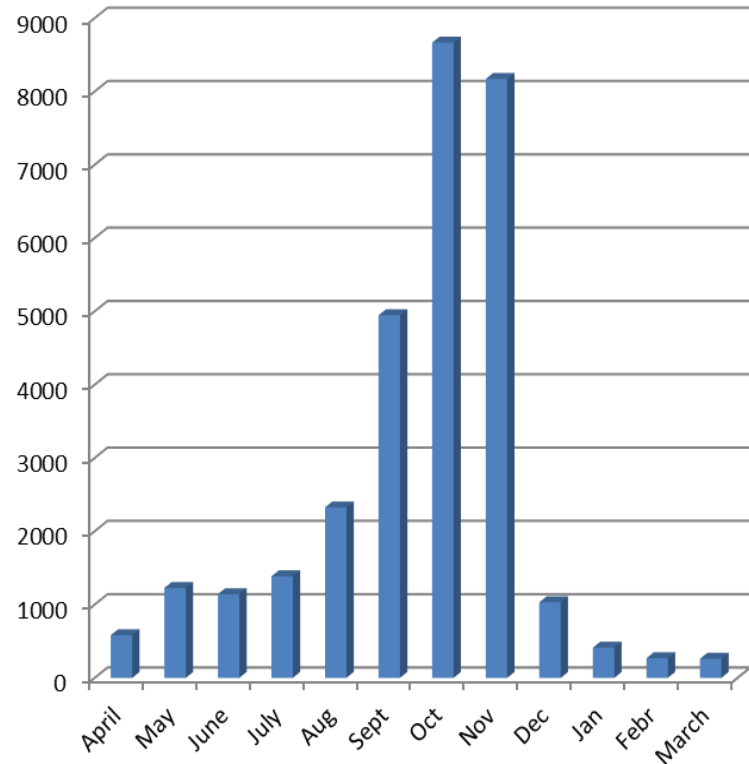
- The projects that have received funds this year all address the objectives in the Barents programme:
 - 1) Prevention and control of non-communicable
 - 2) Prevention and control of communicable diseases
 - 3) Strengthening of health systems and social services with relevance for health

Norwegian authorities' responsibilities

- The Ministry of Justice responsible for the asylum seekers policy in Norway
- The Ministry of Health responsible for the health sector. The Ministry has delegated the responsibility to the Directorate of Health to coordinate the health sector on subordinate level

Migration – Health sector

- All asylum seekers screened for tuberculosis within 14 days of arrival in Norway
- national guidelines advising the municipalities to offer all asylum seekers a GP health examination within 3 months
- Special attention given to the danger of vulnerable asylum seekers with mental disturbances
