Four initiatives:

- 1) How to increase compliance to national guidelines

- 3) How to organise highly specialized care
- 4) How to divide Sweden into functional and efficient regional administrative units

Health professionals

1 billion SEK (agreement with SALAR) to enhance more time for the patient by addressing shortages and promoting efficiency (improve routines, less bureaucracy, adequate e-Health).

Women's health and maternal health

2 billions during 4 years (agreement with SALAR). Increase knowledge, competence and skills, develop and improve.

Address injuries and complications related to delivery. Free of charge mammography.
