Information from BRYC

Tim Andersson, the chairman of BRYC, introduced the BRYC annual event which includes openings ceremony, interactive workshops, a closing dinner on Saturday with musical performances. The participants leave on Sunday.

Over 170 applied to take part, mainly Russians. Only 60 could attend. 15 people per country.

Proposed changes to BRYC organization and new project.

Tim presented a new project idea regarding sexual health. Sexual health is a topic that affects young people and attracts a higher level of interaction within BRYC. It will create connections with NGOs, Parents working groups and community of youth.

The concrete proposal is an international conference in May 2019, possibly in Luleå. Main output: 5 concrete doable conclusions that relevant stakeholders receive.

Tim estimates the cost to be approx. SEK 800 000.

It was emphasized that the working group on education, research and social issues should be involved in this as well. It was suggested to create a collaborative task force with the chairs of the working groups involved. Västerbotten will follow up on this issue.

JWGY supports idea and looks forward to cooperation.

National representatives in JWGY

This point is raised because we have a obvious difficulty in finding national representation to these meetings. Eva Ekmevag will contact the CSO in Norway, Finland and Russia and they will be invited as well as the national representatives. The idea is that the CSO members will perhaps influence the national representatives.

Selection of BRYC representatives

The selection of BRYC representatives varies quite a lot from country to country. It was decided to make an overview of how the BRYC-representatives are chosen in each region. There is a need from both the working group and BRYC for some clarifications regarding this point. Minna made a survey to be disseminated in all regions to get an overview on how selection and recruitment is done in the different places now. The survey was presented and accepted by the working group.
