57th Meeting of the Subgroup for Hot Spots Exclusion (SHE#57)
Telephone Meeting, April 5th, 2017

1. Opening of the Meeting

The telephone meeting was opened at 14.00 (Oslo time) and the following participated:

2. Adoption of the Agenda

The agenda was adopted.

3. Review of Minutes from the SHE 56 Meeting

The SHE group agreed on a few amendments and approved the Minutes from SHE#56 meeting. The approved version will be circulated to the group and translated into Russian.

4. Follow-up of tasks distributed at the previous meetings

The group went through the updated list of follow-up tasks from the minutes of the SHE#56 meeting. SHE has not received response on tasks 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9 regarding Komi hotspots. Henrik Forsström will make inquiries with the NEFCO consultant in Komi about the status of these tasks. These tasks will be forwarded to the new list of follow-ups from the SHE#57 meeting along with task 6, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and some additional tasks. NEFCO will translate a consultant mission report from Komi (visit to hotspot Ko1 and Ko2-1) into English and circulate to SHE.

5. Hotspot A4 - Arkhangelsk Pulp and Paper Mill (Novodvinsk) - Preparations for meeting between SHE and WGE about possible hotspot exclusion

The meeting between WGE and SHE about hotspot A4 has been postponed. The new date is May 23 at 14.00 (Oslo time). The deadline for a SHE statement about A4 exclusion is may 18.

SHE awaits the mission report from the experts meeting in Arkhangelsk in Mid March and the updated TEC review for hotspot A4. Hanne will prepare a draft statement as soon as the TEC review on A4 has been updated and circulate to SHE members for comments.

A question was raised about if it is necessary for A4 hotspot owner to update the Screening and Analyses report for A4? (this would imply that all hotspots seeking exclusion might have to do the same, as it usually takes time from the S&A is prepared until the hotspot is ready for exclusion from the list). Dronova said Arkhangelsk should clarify if they plan to update the S&A report. Hanne agreed to ask Ivan Popov if they plan to update the S&A report when they meet this week and report back to SHE.

6. Support activities

Norway informed that they will send comments on the draft list of Support Activities circulated by Åke Mikaelsson 22.03.2017. They briefly presented the comments. Deadline for comments is April 7.

7. Outreach material for the 2017 Ministerial

Maria Dianova (IBS) was not present at the meeting and Information about the status of the drafting of leaflets for Ko7 and Ko3 was postponed to the next meeting. Ingrid Lillehagen informed that she as the WGE chair will make sure the separate leaflets produced by SHE about hotspots are also assembled in a brochure with a foreword.

8. Date and Topics for Next (SHE) Meeting

Ruslan Butovsky informed about the enquiries about possible dates for a SHE meeting with the BAT Bureau. The BAT bureau is having a seminar in St Petersburg 25-26 May and is able to have a meeting with SHE back to back with this. Another option was in September (23rd). SHE would prefer to have the meeting with the BAT Bureau before the summer 2017 and asked Ruslan to get a confirmation of a meeting in the mentioned week in May in St Petersburg, preferably the 23rd May. Then SHE could also have the next SHE meeting in St Petersburg back to back with this.

Ruslan will check with the BAT Bureau and get back to SHE. (SHE did not discuss location for a possible SHE meeting in St Petersburg).
