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4. Review of Minutes from previous meetings

- i) The Minutes from SHE #85 in Umeå were approved also by Russia, hence they are now fully approved by the whole SHE.
- ii) The Minutes from SHE #86 were approved also by Russia, hence they are now fully approved by the whole SHE. A minor addition from Henrik at NEFCO will be added.
- iii) The Minutes from SHE #87 in Stockholm were approved, with a minor addition from Henrik at NEFCO to be added shortly.

5. Up-date on Correspondence with the Regional Hotspot Exclusion Grouups (Regional HEGs)

- a) Follow-up on communication with the regional HEGs
 - i) <u>Arkhangelsk HEG</u>: The decision at SHE #87 to recommend WGE to exclude hotspot A9-1 from the Barents hotspot list was reconfirmed (this time also with RU).
 - ii) <u>Karelian HEG</u>: The Chair reported briefly from the incl. Skype mweeting held with the Karelian HEG on the 14th of November 2019 and summarized that the following prioritised delieverables had been identified:
 - K2 The Nadvoitsy Aluminium plant has changed its feature completely and aluminium production is no more taking place. Larisa Kolokolnikova promised to submit a presentation on the situation. If a decent Screening & Analysis Reprot is submitted, the hotspot may be subject to fast-track
 - K3 S&A needed
 - K5 Awaiting the work done by the BAT bureau in Support Activities No4+5 (criteria, action plan and report on implementation). The TF on Wastewater should be alerted for the documentation flow.
 - K6 S&A expected to be submitted to SHE at the end of November
 - K7 SHE reviews the documentation provided by the Karelian HEG. An updated TECrevirew will probably be done soon (potential fast-track). TF on Heat and Power plants will review the documents
 - K8 S&A, criteria and action plans need to be submitted by HEG to SHE
 - K9 Material was provided in the summary report provided by Larisa before the HEG meeting. An S&A is needed (potential candidate for fast-track exclusion
 - iii) Komi HEG: No news reported.
 - iv) <u>Murmansk HEG</u>: SHE approved the revised Draft Letter to Murmansk as well as the revised TEC-review on M4. It was agreed that the letter may be sent to Murmansk a.s.a.p., however after the prognosis of the Murmansk consultant's delivery on M3, M5, M6, M7 and M10 has been received.
 - v) <u>Nenets AO HEG</u>: Henrik reported that a visit to NAO will be foretaken by NEFCO, Mr Epov and the BAT-Bureau during the coming week and that the remaining issues regarding N2 and N3 are expected to be clarified.
- Review of the remaining hotspots
 The Overview of Exclusion Documentation in AppSHE#88.8.ii was reviewed and found sufficient as up-dated after the Karelian HEG-meeting.
- c) Decisions on further documentary steps towards exclusion The letters drafted for Archangelsk, Karelia, Komi, Murmansk and Nenets Autonomous Okrug were reviewed and was concluded that Summary of messages with tasks and requests for complementary documentation to be sent from SHE to the respective HEG were sufficient at the moment.





It was agreed that:

=> SHE reviews the documents for comments/approval till the 25th of November 2019.
 => Rickard and Åke produce a timeline for expected deliverables and deadlines (SHE #89)
 => Julia sends all the 88.5a documents for translation into Russian

6. Follow-up and Decisions on further steps with the Support Activities

- a) Follow-up of Conducted and Soon Implemented Support Activities
 - The Chair gave the last Information on the planned Support Activty No4 on Mondi Syktyvkar (Ko3-1) and Petrozavodsk WWTP (K5) respectively, as well as the combined Support Activty No5 for the same plants. Regarding Ko3-2, most preparations for Criteria and EPEP seems to be well on track and expected to be delivered during December 2019. Regarding K5, according to the BAT-Bureau, the time table seems to be a few weeks later.
 - Henrik reported that no contract yet was signed between NEFCO and the Murmansk consultants regarding No6 activities addressed for the Murmansk hotspots M3, M4, M5, M6, M7 and M10 and that he also failed to get in touch with them and thus did not have any new update on the expected delivery date. In any caase, it was clear that the expected Screening & Analysis reports will noty be delivered in November.
- b) Review and up-date of experts in the thematic Task Forces and Technical Expert Committees
 - i) The list of TF experts was briefly reviewed and found sufficient (i.e. no need for up-date)
- c) Review and Final Approval of the ToRs for Support Activities received:

The revised ToR for Support Activity No4+5 addressed for Ko3-2 - Mondi Syktyvkar and K5 - Petrozavodsk WWTP respectively were reviewed. The SHE group encouraged the authors to simplify the ToRs and make them shorter. It would also be good to include a picture of the hotspot exclusion process. Åke informed that the formulations of tasks depending on other parties (e.g. hotspot owners) may be justified as a description of the assignment as a whole but cannot be prescribed in the ToR for a consultant with a task covering just a part of it. <u>It was agreed</u> that Mikael and Tatiana dicuss the ToRs and then send new and simplified versions to SHE for a secondary review for approval.

d) Discussions and Decisions on further Support Activities

The Chair briefly reported on the meeting with the SHE TF On Contaminated Soils on the 15th of November 2019. The TF had received 4 tasks which were dicussed during the meeting:

- i) compile a TEC review on M10;
- ii) draft a ToR for an SuppActNo6 for A7-1;
- iii) draft a ToR for an SuppActNo6 for A9-2;
- iv) draft a ToR for an SuppActNo6 on contaminate soils

It was agreed with the TF that they complete i) till SHE#88 and get back to the SHE Chair during december with suggested delivery dates for ii, iii, and iv.

- 7. Report from the TF on Strategic SHE Communication, and discussion on possible comunication activities for promoting action projects within the HSE Procedure
 - a) Discussion on relevant communication issues
 - i. It was agreed that to the Ministerial Meeting it so far was clear to report on:
 - Exclusion decision on A5 and A9-1
 - Progress made on K5 & Ko3-2 as "double pilots", i.e. both for full-track and FZ-219.





- All the Supporting Activities done so far
- The Brochure of the work conducted during the Swedish Chairmanship
- It was also agreed that the TF for Communication should be ready to support the completion of the communication related sub-steps of the Hot spot exclusion procedure for those hotspots which are subjects to No6 activities.
- b) Decisions on further steps with the communication work
 - Regarding the Communication Workshop, it was agreed that the revised ToR provided as App SHE#88.6ciii should be reviewed for approval/&comments by SHE till the 25th of November 2019
 - Regarding the Hotspot Exclusion Communication Toolbox, it was agreed that the revised ToR provided as App SHE#88.6civ should be reviewed for approval/&comments SHE till the 25th of November 2019
 - iii. The TF on Communication was again requested to make an outreach to regional communication colleagues regarding individual hotspots
 - iv. The draft version of the "Newsflash" on the Ko5 and Ko3-2 (AppSHE#88.7aii) was approved by SHE. All SHE-members were encouraged to publish it on their organizational website.

8. Discussion and Decisions on SHE's Reporting to WGE

- a) It was agreed that SHE at WGE#53 should:
 - Recommended A5 and A9-1 for Exclusion via Fast Track at the XIV Ministerial Meeting in Luleå on the 4-5th of February 2020
 - ii) Announce as probable for Exclusion via Full Track ("Double Pilots"): K5 and Ko3-2
 - iii) Announce as possible for Exclusion via Fast Track also: A1-1, M3, M4, M5, M6, M7, M10
- b) Report on State of Exclusion and Support Activities
- c) Report on Achievements in relation to SHE Work Programme 2018-2019
- d) Regarding the discussion on Future Perspectives for the Hot Spots Work, no specific issues were yet addressed.
