The WGIP should decide on a contact person for this work, who will participate in the planning with the above mentioned partners. The seminar is planned as a follow-up on the Conference in Kirkenes (February 2012) and the seminar in Tromsø (September 2012). The event in Kautokeino will also mark the kick-off for the cooperation project between Kautokeino and Zapolyarny Rayon/Nenets AO/Naryan-Mar on reindeer husbandry and culture.

Secretariat will inform on budget for holding the seminar.
