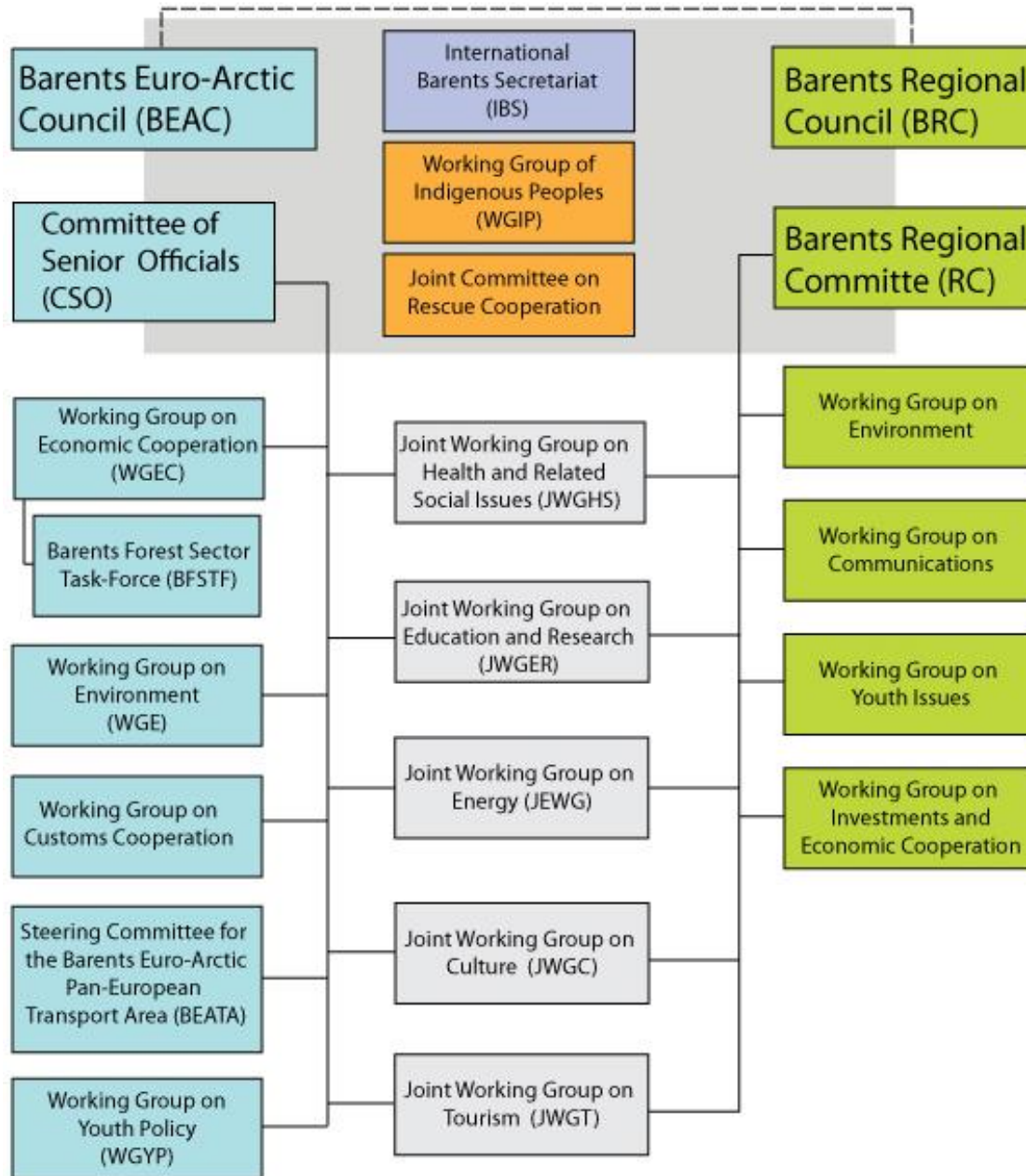

At the meeting in Jokkmokk the Nenets, the Saami and the Vepsian peoples were all represented for the first time, this being a major step towards integrating the Indigenous peoples in the Barents cooperation. The meeting also focused on the progress of the 16 working groups where the concrete work is done in the Barents cooperation.
